Tisha B'Av This Weekend Saturday night, August 6, 9:00 PM Sunday morning, August 7, 9:00 AM

The fast day of Tisha B'Av, commemorating the destruction of the First and Second Temples and the loss of Jewish independence, is coming up soon. BZBI will gather in the Goldberg Sanctuary on Saturday night, August 6, at 9:00 PM for a subdued Maariv (evening) service, reading of Megillat Aicha (the Book of Lamentations), and *Kinnot* (mourning hymns), and in the Klinghoffer Chapel on Sunday morning, August 7, at 9:00 AM for Shacharit (morning) service with Torah reading.
