All ages packing is from **10:00-11:30 AM**. Food delivery will start at either **10:00 AM or 11:30 AM**. After packing, volunteers are also able to deliver packages on a specified delivery route.

As Israel swears in a new government that looks radically different from the previous one, what can we expect to see in the Middle East?
